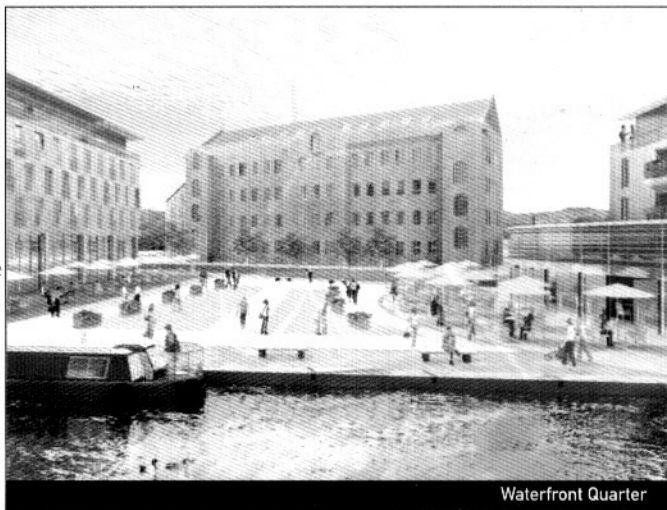


NEW HUDDERSFIELD WATERFRONT PLANS UNVEILED

Revised proposals for one of the largest urban renewal projects in the country have been revealed. The £175 million Waterfront Quarter development in Huddersfield, which will occupy almost one mile of frontage to the River Colne and The Huddersfield Narrow Canal at the gateway to the Colne Valley, has been enhanced following extensive public consultation. Developments' imaginative scheme will provide 817,000 sq ft of prestigious mixed-use buildings within an iconic setting with the potential of creating up to 2,000 jobs for the UK's largest town. The revised scheme has been submitted for planning approval and will be considered by the planning sub-committee (Huddersfield area) of Kirklees Metropolitan Council on September 21.
